

On July 9, 2010, Eric J. Davis obtained “Not Guilt” verdicts on behalf of a client charged with four counts of medicare fraud and one count of conspiracy to commit medicare fraud in the United States District Court for the Southern District of Texas, Houston Division, in Cause No. H-09-425.

Our client was the owner of a durable medical equipment company (DME). And was accused of conspiring with others in billing medicare over \$1 million dollars for medical equipment, much of which the government argued was not medically necessary. The case was investigated and prosecuted by a specialized task force assigned to medicare cases. The government also sought the forfeiture of the client’s assets. Following a jury trial, the Client was **acquitted of all charges.**
